



# Planning Scholarship Students

Far North District Council is offering two student Scholarships for 2012 and is calling for applications from students interested in careers in planning. The scholarship programme includes financial support, university holiday work relevant to the student's chosen course of study, and full time employment when they complete their study.

Applicants can be students who are just beginning their university studies, or part way through their degree.

## **To qualify students must:**

- Be current residents and have attended secondary school in the Far North District; although they may be currently studying in another centre
- Be a New Zealand citizen or a New Zealand permanent resident
- Hold the National Certificate in Educational Achievement (NCEA) Level 3
- Hold other qualifications recognised for University Entrance, or have partially completed tertiary qualifications that in general have met a high standard
- They must also be prepared to work for a minimum bonded period of two years
